

1. The Clerk following council members were present, Messrs S. F. Woodingham, A. H. Gidney, F. Cooper, J. Gibson, J. W. Curson, & Graver, A. Green.
2. The Clerk took the Chair, & it was unanimously agreed that the election of the Chairman should be first on the agenda.
3. It was proposed by S. F. Woodingham that A. H. Gidney be Chairman of the Council for the ensuing year, this was seconded by J. W. Curson, & passed unanimously.
4. A. H. Graver proposed, & A. Green seconded that S. F. Woodingham be Vice-Chairman of the Council for the ensuing year. This proposition was put to the meeting & passed unanimously.
5. The Parish Councillors signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office.

It was agreed upon the motion of S. F. Wordingham, seconded by H. Green (after the minutes had been read by ~~that~~ the Chairman) that the minutes of the last meeting be passed, & signed by the Chairman.

6. The correspondence was read by the Chairman.
5. 7. J. W. Cusson proposed, & H. Gravet seconded, that S. F. Wordingham be nominated to the post of School Manager, (term 3 years). This proposition was put to the meeting & passed, & the form pertaining to the nomination was duly completed.
7. 8. It was agreed upon the motion of S. F. Wordingham, seconded by J. W. Gibson that a Precept for £5 (five pounds) be officially signed, to be delivered to the Clerk of the Walsingham Rural District Council.
6. 9. The Clerk, who had acted as Chairman of the Parish Meeting whereat the Councillors were elected, laid his expenses before the meeting, amounting to 2/3<sup>2</sup> (two shillings & threepence half-penny) being the cost of two Parish Registers of Electors. The Clerk also intimated to the meeting that the following items were due from the Council, 4/9 for a new Precept-Book, 10/- due to the Clerk of Walsingham R. D. C. for expenses & fee while acting as the Returning Officer for the Council election. S. F. Wordingham proposed, & T. Cooper seconded that a cheque for 10/- be paid to the Clerk of the Walsingham R. D. C., & another to the Clerk of this Council for £1-4-0, (the £1 being the Clerk's half-yearly salary to the first week in April) when the amount of the Precept was

received from Walsingham, because there was not sufficient funds in standing to the accounts of this Council at the present time to meet these items. The above proposition was put to the meeting & passed unanimously.

A cheque for £6 (six pounds) was signed & made payable to J. R. C. Draper being allotment rents for the half-year.

The Chairman gave a few items of information regarding the proposed new Council houses, & no other business being forthcoming, the Chairman declared the meeting closed.
