

The vote was thanked by Miss Greenyer who said


that next year there would have to be a

Complaints were made of the drains being blocked in Bridge Street and flooding which was caused when there was heavy rain.

Miss Greenyer said the Council had put barms at the entrance of her drive and the water from the road had caused a gully which was dangerous.
