• ***Police Crime Report***

The report of crimes for this last month is as follows:-

For calls in total were made to the police, resulting in no crimes being recorded. The crimes were as listed one grade B – no further details available and three grade D – a hoax 999 call, report about the live ammunition shell found on the beach and report of a road traffic accident in Norwich.

Trading Standards – there has been a series of scams which are people contacting you purporting to be British Telecom asking for your code will your keys safe. Should you come across this particular type of scam contact the citizens advice bureau on telephone number (0845) 404 0506, and they will give advice and any assistance.

Broadband – the broadband is ahead of schedule and there has been some of £5.5 million designated for the areas. There is the question with regard to match funding for this money, which would equate to £11.8 million. Marie reported that some of the other villagers, such as Letheringsett, Little Thornage and the Barshams are ahead of time with regard to their installations. Marie also reported that they were well ahead in the Wells next the Sea installation. Wells is spread over three cycles.
